***All Directions are from Greenville:***

1. **#18 Mullaney Lane, Greenville, the garden of Byron and Shirley Chitwood.**  
Go South on Hwy. 69 toward Lone Oak. Turn Right on Mullaney Ln in Oak Village. Garden on the right.
2. **902 River Oaks Dr., Greenville, the garden of Beverly Boshear.**  
Directly across from Mullaney Ln is River Oaks subdivision. Turn in on Horne Dr. and immediately turn right onto River Oaks Dr. The garden will be on the left at the end.
3. **4013 Dixon Circle, Greenville, the garden of Bobby and Nancy Oliver.**  
Take Moulton Street/Business 69 and turn east on Division. Turn on Dixon Circle, garden will be on the right.
4. **2367 County Road 3517, Quinlan, the garden of Kim and Keith Quimby**  
Take Hwy. 69 South toward Lone Oak, turn right onto FM 2947, turn right onto CR 3517 (approx. 3mi.) Garden will be on the left.
5. **5399 County Road 3521, Quinlan, the garden of Claudine and Don Anderson.**  
Take Hwy. 69 South toward Lone Oak, turn right onto FM 2947, turn right onto CR 3517 go approximately 1 mile and turn right onto CR 3521 go straight do not turn when rock road turns left. Garden will be straight ahead.
6. **3080 County Road 3115, Greenville, the garden of Anita Harris**  
Go East on I-30 toward Commerce, take Exit 97(Lamar St.) Turn left on the service road and go 3 miles, turn right on FM 1737. Go 3.1 miles on 1737 and it will turn into CR 3115. Garden will be marked by a pipe fence on the left.
7. **4261 Barnes Drive, Campbell TX the garden of June Dunn**  
From I-30, exit 101 toward Commerce on Highway 24. Travel approximately 8 miles and turn right on FM 1568, take an immediate left on Barnes Drive. Garden on right two story house.
8. **3248 County Road 1105, Celeste, the garden of Pat and Arnie Abramson.**  
From Hwy. 380 /69 North turn right on Hwy. 69 North, go 5.7 miles to FM 2194. Turn left and go approximately 5.5 miles to the end. Turn left and go .4 miles where it turns into FM 2194 again. Travel approximately 1.6 miles, turn right onto CR 1105. Garden 4<sup>th</sup> house on left.
9. **2098 FM 1566 West, Celeste TX the garden of Pat Newell.**  
Take Hwy 69 North to FM 272 on outskirts of Celeste. Turn right on FM 272 and go 2 miles. Turn right on FM 1566 West and go about 3 miles. House and garden will be on the left.
